

## 2021 Lapeer Robotics ROBOCON Competition - COVID Safety Guidelines

1. Face masks that cover the nose and mouth must be worn inside at all times regardless of vaccination status.

- Please comply with this and when needed take “mask breaks” outside the venue.
- **We do realize that local and state guidelines do not require this, but given the current environment of the FIRST community and guidelines set by them to be able to host in person events, we are putting this measurement in place and appreciate your cooperation.**
- If you have a medical condition that prevents you from wearing a mask, please bring in a medical note in regard to this and give it to the Check In attendants.  
*(this is being addressed since we have been asked about it)*

2. Currently there are no restrictions on the number of attendees, going in accordance to State and school guidelines. However, we ask that everyone practices social distancing whenever possible.

3. Health screenings will be required for everyone, regardless of vaccination status.

- Everyone in attendance must check in individually each day before entering the venue.
- Forms will be filled out by each person on the day they attend. It will be available electronically for teams to share with attendees as well. We will have paper copies available for those who did not have access to this, but filling out electronically will speed up the check in process.
  - Anyone unable to pass screening will not be allowed into the event.
- Temp checks will be done.
- Wristbands given out to those who have been screened and should be worn where they are visible by event volunteers.

4. Food

- There will be seating available for teams in the cafeteria. However, those with safety concerns are welcome to bring tents and tables for outside eating on the grounds of the venue. This may also give you a bigger space if your team is larger in size.
- No food is permitted in the pit area.
- Concessions will consist only of bottled water and pre-packaged snacks. No hot foods or lunch pre-orders.
- Teams are responsible for bringing their own food.
